<p>Evaluation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All PP pupils accessed wider school opportunities. • PP pupils are progressing well compared to their peers. Where this is not the case, there is another issue impacting on progress. • Y6 outcomes highlighted above. Small cohort size of PP pupils makes comparisons difficult.
