I included a free code for a Twinkl account in your lockdown packs.</p> <p>Practical activities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use coins or beads and create arrays. To do this if you want to work out what 5 groups of 3 is, you would make 3 lines of 5 coins and the children would add them up at the end.• Practise halving: Get two plates and some sweets/fruit. If you were halving the amount how many would each person get? Try this with different amounts of plates to divide by different amounts.• Practise your number bonds to 20. How quickly can you write them all?• Practise your place value knowledge up to 100. Please concentrate on using capital letters, full stops, finger spaces, adjectives and ensuring that letters are correctly formed and on the line. Try and include 'and' into your sentences and 'because'.

Please re-read *Commotion in the Ocean – Giles Andreae* before attempting the lessons below. If you do not have the book at home, there are videos of people reading the book on YouTube.

Pick one task to complete each day.

1. Throughout the story, new creatures are introduced using short rhyming poems. Can you create your own poem for a sea creature of your choice?
2. There are many different types of sea creatures in the story. Which of the sea creatures is your favourite and why?
3. There are facts about each of the sea creatures hidden within the poems. Can you choose a sea creature from the story to research and to make a fact file about?
4. If you could have one of the sea creatures special feature or skills for the day, what would you choose, and why? (for example, would you have 8 arms or be able to swim underwater for a long time?).
5. See if you can invent your own sea creature and then draw a picture of it. What features would it have? Would it have any special features or skills?

Learning project for this week:

1. Science

Watch a David Attenborough documentary about the sea (Blue Planet is a good one). Do you see any of the creatures that were in this week's book? Can you make a fact file about one of the animals from the Tv show. Remember to draw lots of pictures.

Learn about different habitats across the world.
