Learning project: Celebrations	
The project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to learn more about the celebrations around the world.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Find out about celebrations around the world. They could use the internet to research Chinese New Year, Ramadan, Holi Festival, New Year's Eve, Thanksgiving, etc. The children can create a fact file or make a PowerPoint on the celebration they have researched. • Design and make bunting, decorations or party hats for a Street Party. • Try using YouTube for Joe Wicks workout for kids or Oti Mabuse Kids dance classes. • Learn about tessellation using https://www.mathsisfun.com/geometry/tessellation.html Children can use tessellation to design their own wrapping paper using: https://nrich.maths.org/6069 • Find out about traditional dishes served at festivals around the world. Make a celebration dish – it could be a birthday cake, apple pie, sweets for Diwali or potato latkes.
