

# Catch it, bin it, kill it



## CATCH IT

Germs spread easily. Always carry tissues and use them to catch your cough or sneeze.



## BIN IT

Germs can live for several hours on tissues. Dispose of your tissue as soon as possible.



## KILL IT

Hands can transfer germs to every surface you touch. Clean your hands as soon as you can.

# Social Distancing

- Children do not need to social distance in their bubble.
- We need to stay in our year group bubble.
- Different year groups have different start and end times.
- We will play on our own section of the playground.
- Children need to face the front of the classroom.
- Children need to try to stay 2m from the adults in school.





# Classrooms

- Sit at the same table every day (learning partners may change each week).
- Everyone must have their own water bottle which you need to put on or under your table.
- Only use the pens, pencils, books, etc you have been given.
- Remember the teacher needs to try to stay 2m away from you.
- If you need to sneeze or cough, use a tissue and put it in the bin once it has been used. Then wash your hands.
- Tables will need to be cleaned down before and after lunch.
- Children will eat their pack lunch in the classrooms.
- There will be no assemblies in the hall.





# Classrooms

- We can share equipment within our bubbles, but not with other bubbles. Where possible, equipment will be cleaned once it has been used.
- We will be able to use the hall for PE lessons.
- Children won't be able to go on messages or do jobs around the school. We need to stay in our bubble areas.





# Rewards and Consequences

We **always** love to see the **wonderful behaviour** from all our children at Lingfield and we **enjoy** rewarding this and the **hard work** you do. However, at the moment, our rewards are a little different.

- Teachers will not be able to give you stickers because it could spread germs.
- We will not be able to give merits at the moment either.
- But, teachers **will** send home Marvellous Me messages for good work, excellent behaviour and for having a positive attitude.
- Teachers **will** give house points, particularly for excellent behaviour, following instructions and following all our new rules to help to keep each other safe.
- We will also tell you when we are pleased with your work and wonderful behaviour.





# Rewards and Consequences

If children do not behave sensibly and follow our school rules, we will:

- Give a **reminder** about expected behaviour. (if a serious incident, name may be moved on the behaviour chart).
- Give a **reminder** about expected behaviour, moving that child's name down the behaviour chart.
- If this behaviour continues, **time out** will be given in the classroom and the child's name will be moved down the behaviour chart again.
- If another reminder about behaviour is needed, **up to 15 minutes** will be taken from the next playtime and the child's name will be moved down the behaviour chart once again.
- If unacceptable behaviour still continues, the **head teacher** or **deputy head** will speak to that child and may need to inform their parents.

# Playtimes



- We play in the same area of the playground each break and every day.
- We must not go out of our coned area.
- We cannot bring toys or equipment in from home.



# First Aid

- If you need first aid, a member of staff will need to come closer to you.
- They will need to wear gloves, goggles, an apron and a mask to protect themselves and you from any unwanted germs.



# Cloakrooms and Toilets

- Don't use the water fountains.
- Only one bubble allowed in the toilets at a time.
- Remember to wash your hands after using the toilet.
- If you need to go during a lesson, remember to ask first so the teacher knows who has left the classroom.
- Put your coat and PE bag on your peg.
- Put your book bag in your tray.
- Put your lunch box in your cubby.



# What if I feel poorly?



- If you start to feel unwell, a member of staff may ask you to go with them to sit in the Music Room. This so that no unwanted germs can be spread to other people.



# Worries



- We know it is very different here at the moment and you have been away from school for a long time. If you have any worries, please talk to us. We will try our best to help and make you feel safe. Please don't keep your worries inside. We are all part of the Lingfield family, and we want our family to be as happy, safe and loved as possible.
